POLICY: P-1 PACIFIC ISLAND STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT NAG 1

Purpose

A key goal of the School is to improve the learning achievement of Pacific Island students.

The School will, where possible, implement fully monitored and reported support programmes to improve the achievement of these students.

Policy

1. The school will identify Pacific Island students as a cohort group.
2. Pacific Island student achievement data from school wide testing of numeracy and literacy will be identified and analysed as a separate cohort.
3. At the beginning of the year Pacific Island student achievement data will be reported to parents/caregivers.
4. Pacific Island students who are identified as significantly underachieving will be included in all available programmes to boost their achievement levels.
5. Parents/caregivers of Pacific Island students involved in booster programmes will be informed of their child's involvement, the reason for that involvement, and the content and nature of the programmes.
6. The progress and achievement of Pacific Island students involved in booster programmes will be monitored by the teachers implementing the programmes and reported to the students' parents/caregivers.
7. Data from comparative school-wide testing at the end of the year will be reported to the Board and to the students' parents/caregivers.
8. The success and appropriateness of the programmes delivered to boost the numeracy and literacy skills of Pacific Island students will be reviewed annually.
